EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT/DEEPWATER HORIZON EXTENDED EMERGENCY ORDER (Pursuant to Executive Orders No. 10-99 and 10-132)

I hereby find that pursuant to Executive Order 10-99, as extended by Executive Order 10-132, the Department of Transportation's assistance continues to be required to protect Florida's coastline and the general welfare of the State as a result of the crude oil leaking from the Deepwater Horizon drilling platform and well beginning April 21, 2010, and such assistance is hindered by statute, rule, or order.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted by Section 4 of Executive Order 10-99 and Executive Order 132, I hereby suspend any statute, rule, or order, as needed to allow the establishment of alternate size and weight restrictions for commercial vehicles transporting emergency equipment, services, and supplies, and to provide for the issuance of temporary permits for the transport of emergency equipment, services, and supplies subject to the limitations expressed in Executive Orders 10-99 and 10-132.

This order shall expire on the earlier of the expiration or rescission of Executive Order 10-99, as extended, or thirty (30) days from the date of this Emergency Order, unless extended by me.
